The Buena Vista Vinicultural Society was formed in 1863 by the winery's founder, Count Agoston Haraszthy, to further improve its winemaking prowess and expand its vineyards. The Vinicultural Society has been restored as a collection of unique small-production wines that honor the winery's pioneering spirit and contribution to California winemaking. The collection of wines explores clonal selections, varietals and the incredible terroir of Northern California.

#### WINEMAKER'S NOTES

The grapes were harvested on September 2nd, from the Fanucchi-Wood Road vineyard located on the Olivet bench in the Russian River Valley. The wine was aged in concrete which lends texture and softening along with a sense of minerality.

#### TASTING NOTES

Fragrant notes of Meyer lemon, crisp green apple, and fresh lime zest rise from the glass, instantly enlivening the senses. On the palate, this bright and refreshing white wine reveals layers of juicy melon, ripe nectarine, and delicate honeysuckle, harmonized by vibrant acidity. A graceful mid-weight texture and a touch of earthy minerality add depth, culminating in a clean, invigorating finish that lingers with finesse.
