2014 SPARKLING BRUT ROSE

While Agoston Haraszthy was most recognized as being the Father of California viticulture, he was also the father of six illustrious children. His third son, Arpad, spent over two years in France learning the craft of sparkling wine and later became the first to introduce Méthode Traditionelle sparkling wine into California winemaking.

Arpad's sparkling wine, Eclipse, was one of the most celebrated in the nineteenth century; we pay tribute to his legacy through this Brut Rosé sparkling wine of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay grapes.

With grapes harvested from the beautiful Napa Valley Carneros region, this sparkling wine highlights the delicate balance and harmony between the noble Pinot Noir and elegant Chardonnay grapes.

A stunning salmon color in the glass, our 2014 Sparkling Brut Rosé opens with inviting notes of fresh spring leaves and red fruit aromas while flavors of wild strawberry, ripe peach, vanilla crème and hints of rose petal caress the palate. A beautifully seductive yet crisp finish rounds out this delectable, graceful sparkling wine.
